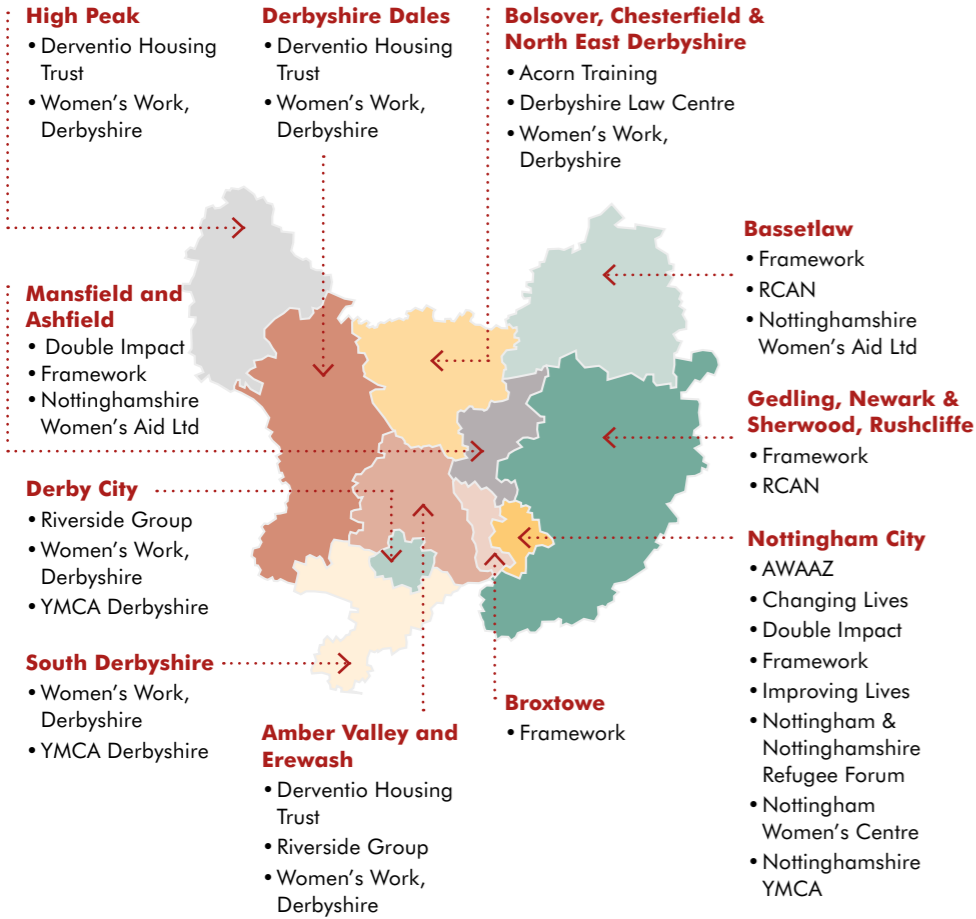

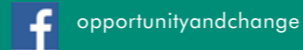

about Opportunity and Change

Opportunity and Change is a support programme for people with multiple and complex needs. The programme is being delivered by a partnership of organisations throughout Derby, Derbyshire, Nottingham and Nottinghamshire, led by Framework.

The programme is part of the national Building Better Opportunities programme funded by the Big Lottery Fund and the European Social Fund.

programme aims

The aim of the programme is to support people who are:

- **Homeless or vulnerably housed**
- **Misusing substances**
- **Experiencing mental health issues**
- **Experiencing domestic abuse**
- **Current or ex-offenders**

With the aim of helping them resolve their complex needs and become socially and economically included through access to education, training and employment.

Each person will be allocated a locally based 'Navigator' who will support them to achieve their goals in partnership with existing support agencies where they are already involved.

eligibility

Each participant must have at least two of the complex needs outlined on page 3.

Each participant **MUST** be able to prove that they have the Right to Work in the UK and that they are unemployed or economically inactive.

Evidence of this includes:

- Passport
- Full Birth Certificate
- National insurance card or a letter from HMRC (we can help you with this)
- Letter from the Job Centre that includes NINO and DOB
- Letter from HMRC - We can help you with this.

All participant support costs are met by the programme including:

- Childcare
- Interpretation and translation
- Travel
- One off items to help you meet your support plan goals.

Additional support includes:

- Specialist counselling services
- Peer support
- Volunteering
- Bite size learning and training opportunities focusing on personal development, wellbeing, employment and maintaining your home.
